Assistive Technology Decision Making Series

This video series addresses the AT decision making process and reviews the source for the information and related information behind it, the Quality Indicators for Assistive Technology.

1. **Legal Requirements and Team Responsibilities** The first video in the series provides an overview of the AT decision making process. It discusses the law and team responsibilities. **Running Time:** 13:06 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
2. **AT Consideration** The second video addresses the reasons for considering assistive technology, defines consideration and who is responsible for considering within the context of an IEP meeting. **Running Time:** 19:38 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
3. **The Referral Process** The third video addresses recommendations for the referral process, including pre-referral, establishing procedures, and guiding questions. **Running Time:** 18:20 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
4. **Information Gathering and Feature Matching** The fourth video elaborates on the components of the SETT decision making framework, the Student, Environment, Task and Tools. **Running Time:** 19:18 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
5. **AT Assessment** The fifth video addresses the assessment process based on a determination of the task being addressed, a trial, data collection, and determining success. **Running Time:** 12:18 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
6. **Data Collection and Analysis** The final video in the series address how data is used to determine a student's AT needs, and how data is used to document a student's performance during the assessment time-frame. **Running Time:** 25:06 minutes; **Learning Credits:** .5
