### Hidden Curriculum Series

#### **Part I: The Brain & ASD & Its Impact on Instruction, Academics & Challenging Behavior**

Dr. Myles has completed a review of neurology literature and shares how autism impacts individuals in the classroom. She includes images of brain scans that compare typically developing brains with brains of autistic individuals. Discussed are reinforcement, self-regulation, aggression, learning, memory, sensory and motor systems, pseudo-logic and implicit learning, theory of mind and problem solving. This is not to be missed if you teach or work with students with ASD.
