Organizational Supports

Bubbl.us

This is a simple, free online graphic organizer which allows you to save your work, print or share with others.

Circle Plot Diagram

This tool from ReadWriteThink can be used as a prewriting graphic organizer for students writing original stories with a circular plot structure (e.g., If You Take a Mouse to School), as well as a post-reading organizer used to explore the text structures in a book.

Compare & Contrast Map

This interactive graphic organizer from ReadWriteThink helps students develop an outline for one of three types of comparison essays: whole-to-whole, similarities-to-differences, or point-to-point.

Cube Creator

Use this tool from ReadWriteThink with its four options. Bio Cube is used when writing about a biography or autobiography. Mystery Cube is used to sort out clues from a mystery or to develop outlines to write a mystery. Story Cube is used to summarize key elements in a story. Create Your Own Cube is used to generate your own questions or topics. Cubes can be saved to revise later. Specific prompts help students generate responses for each type of cube.

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Genre-Focused Planning Strategies

Planning strategies help students achieve the related goals of generating, organizing, and sifting ideas for a paper. Planning strategies typically use acronyms to encapsulate the multiple steps involved and some sort of graphic organizer to record ideas. Genre-focused planning strategies have the additional benefit of triggering writing ideas that fit a particular text organization structure (e.g., narrative).

Persuasion Map

The Persuasion Map from ReadWriteThink is an interactive graphic organizer that enables students to map out their arguments for a persuasive essay or debate.
