Developing a Comprehensive Implementation Plan for Students with Autism

The Comprehensive Autism Planning System (CAPS) is designed to provide an overview of an individual's daily schedule and the supports needed during each period according to activity and task demands. The CAPS is designed to capture the unique strategies implemented for an individual with autism. This presentation explains how the CAPS is used to create a thoughtful balance to the student's/child's day for implementation of instruction that meets the individual's learning needs.
