Adapting on the Fly: Making Complex Academic Learning Accessible for Students with Intellectual Disabilities

Presented by Dr. Phyllis Brodsky, Assistant Professor of Practice, Office of Instruction and Assessment, University of Arizona

For inclusion to be successful, students with intellectual disabilities must have authentic access to grade level content. Teachers and paraprofessionals often collaborate to adapt complex academic concepts and, ideally, adaptations can be planned for and prepared in advance. But paraprofessionals and other support professionals often face the need to adapt content on the fly. By seeing real-life examples, responding to real-life case studies, and having the opportunity to engage with specific iPad apps, this presentation explores the integration of best practices with iOS technology for the purpose of quickly adapting general education lessons in minutes.
